

Coastline Community College and KOCE-TV Telecast Educational Series

March 24, 2003 Fountain Valley, CA - David G. Diaz, MD, Medical Director of West Coast Fertility Centers was selected by Coastline Community College to participate in the development of two educational Telecourses designed for community college students and distance learners.

The unique learning experience of the Telecourse series is to take specific learning objectives and combine it with "real life" stories. For this series, Dr. Diaz discussed the major causes of infertility and the range of treatment options. Patient case studies were presented along with videos of actual procedures demonstrating advanced fertility methods. The titles of the two series are: **Child Development Stepping Stones, Prenatal Special Topics: "A Delicate Grasp," and Transations Through the Lifespan: "The Wonderous Journe: Prenatal Development and Birth."**

Course is airing Spring 2003 session.

This is the second time WCFC was selected to participate with Coastline Commnity College, as a previously recorded Telecourse, "**Cycles of Life**" was well received by undergraduates enrolled in biology classes throughout the community college system.
